Am / Is / Are

Am / is / are are present simple verb forms of *be*.

Here are some examples:

I am Sun Tae-G



I am from Pusan.

He is 25 years old.

His parents are architects.

Present Simple - Positive / Short Form

I am Australian. I'm Australian.

We are Australian. We're Australian.

You are Australian. You're Australian.

They are Australian. They're Australian.

He/she/it is Australian. He's / she's / it's Australian.

Present Simple - Negative / Short Form

I am not Australian. I'm not Australian.

We are not Australian. We're not Australian.

You are not Australian. You're not Australian.

They are not Australian. They're not Australian.

He/she/it is not Australian. He isn't / she isn't / it isn't Australian.

Present Simple - Question

Am I Australian?

Are we Australian?

Are you Australian?

Are they Australian?

Is he / she / it Australian?
